## 'Nut Free Zone' - We need your assistance!

As we now have several children in school who suffer from nut allergies, please could I take this opportunity to remind everyone that our school and Nursery are "Nut Free Zones". Those children, if they come in contact with a nut product, can suffer life threatening consequences. A child with a nut allergy does not have to eat nuts themselves to react, it sometimes only needs to be a touch from someone who has eaten them. **I cannot stress how important it is for everyone to work with us to ensure the safety of all our children.**

This means that the following items cannot be bought into school or nursery;

- Packs of nuts/any nuts
- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
- Cakes made with nuts
- Nutella
- Chocolates
- Baklava
- Nougat
- Biscuits (Check all biscuit labels and if you are not sure please leave it out).



Many foods will contain the wording:

- *May contain traces of nuts*
- *We cannot guarantee that this product does not contain nuts*
- *Produced in a factory which handles nut ingredients*

We do not expect you to avoid all of these foods, just those which directly contain nuts or nut products.

Our catering company, Chartwells has a policy not to use nuts in any of their food prepared on site at our school. Their suppliers provide them with nut-free products; however, they cannot guarantee freedom from nut traces.

Actions by School Staff:


Staff will continue to monitor packed lunches at lunchtime as much as possible.
