The CACOT Children's forum agreed to hold a charity event later in the year to support the great work Canterbury Food Bank do. In the meantime, our Year 2's would like to raise your awareness of the BankTheFood app which we were told about. You can download it onto your mobile phone and it can tell you what items our local food bank is currently in need of.
