Year 2 Swimming Lessons

Year 2 swimming lessons will be starting on Friday 19th September. Please can your child wear their swimming costume and bring a towel to school in a separate bag. The children will walk to and from the pool and be back at school before lunchtime.



The lessons will be subsidised by the school but we are requesting a contribution of £35.00 for all 10 lessons, payable in advance of the first lesson.

Animate Arts POLAR Installation

As many of you will already know, each year we create a new art installation in our entrance hall which is linked to the priorities on the School Development Plan. This year our acronym is POLAR. We will write to you all next week with further details of the school priorities. We are excited to announce that we will again be linking with our long-standing arts partners at Animate Arts Company to create this new display. Jo from Animate Arts has been working alongside each class to gather their ideas and plan the installation. Jo will return on Thursday 18th September to bring all of the children's creations together in our school entrance. Animate Arts

You will remember that at the end of last academic year, the children created artworks inspired by famous portraits that were hung in our St Alphege gallery. Next week, Jo from Animate Arts Company will be returning to school to work alongside Reception children and groups of children from Years 1 and 2 to create a few additional pieces which will be added to this installation. We will share photographs of the finished pieces on the school Facebook page and we also hope that you will come and see them when you are in school for the open session this term.

Nut Free School

We have several children in school who suffer from nut allergies. Please could I remind everyone that our school and Nursery are "Nut Free Zones". Those children, if they come in contact with a nut product, can suffer life threatening consequences. A child with a nut allergy does not have to eat nuts themselves to react, it sometimes only needs to be a touch from someone who has eaten them. I cannot stress how important it is for everyone to work with us to ensure the safety of all our children.



This means that the following items cannot be bought into school or nursery;

- -Packs of nuts/any nuts
- -Peanut butter sandwiches
- -Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- -Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
- -Cakes made with nuts
- -Nutella
- -Chocolates
- -Baklava
- -Nougat
- -Biscuits (Check all biscuit labels and if you are not sure please leave it out).

Many foods will contain the wording:

- May contain traces of nuts
- We cannot guarantee that this product does not contain nuts
- Produced in a factory which handles nut ingredients

We do not expect you to avoid all of these foods, just those which directly contain nuts or nut products. Please help us in providing a nut free school, minimising the risk for children as much as possible and assisting those parents who have children who may have a life threatening reaction.



We have focused on building relationships and learning routines while we play and explore the nursery environment. We had a visit from Animate Art's artist, Jo, who has set us a challenge to make lots of baby penguins and icebergs for the new art installation in the main school foyer.

Year R Mrs Keeble and Mrs Hopkins

Thank you for a fantastic first full week in Reception! We are delighted with how the children are becoming familiar with their new routines, building their resilience, and getting to know their new grown-ups and other children. It has been a pleasure to see their little personalities begin to emerge! We have introduced 'dough disco', which is one of the ways that we develop our fine motor skills. The children have learnt how to pour themselves milk or water at snack time, and we have discussed our school rules and expectations: being ready, respectful and safe. Please could we ask that all children have a named water bottle in school each day and that all items of clothing are named.

What an amazing week we have all had together in Year 1. The children have loved exploring our new text 'The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch' throughout their Imagination week in English. Next week, we will be making sandwiches and using all our fabulous food vocabulary to write instructions. In Maths, the children have been retrieving their knowledge of numbers from 1 to 10 and learning to write them as words. Next week, they will learn how to find one more or one less of a number, and practice how to count backwards. The children have already impressed us with their retrieval of learning in both science and geography lessons where we have been learning about our local community and looking at maps. Next week, they will continue to build on their understanding of the important roles within our community and people who help us. The children loved their special visit from Jo from Animate arts at the end of the week and are super excited to create art work that will contribute to our new school display for next week too! Wishing all our families a joyful and weekend.

Year 2

We have had a wonderful week in Year 2! The children have loved reading the story 'Meerkat Mail' throughout our imagination week in English and have completed engaging activities including making suitcases, creating postcards and packing their suitcases. Next week we will be thinking about the impact adjectives have on a sentence and describing a chosen setting as well as using verbs to explain what they can do in their setting. In Maths, we have been focusing on place value and recapping how to partition tens and ones to use next week when we partition two digit numbers up to 99. In Geography, we learnt all about climate and discussed how the climate may differ in each continent. We plotted this on a world map as a class and thought about which animals may live where and why. We had an exciting visit from Animate Arts and are very much looking forward to creating the art work next week which will be added to our new entrance display in school!
